



Technical Bulletin Hazard Communication

We have been advised by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) that our electrical components are not subject to the hazard communication standard as it relates to providing material safety data sheets.

We are advised that our products meet the definition of an "Article" as defined in 1910.1200 Hazard Communication Standard, Section (b), (6) and Section (c) definitions.

"Article" means a manufactured item: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent, in whole or in part, upon the shape or design during end use; and (iii) which does not release or otherwise result in exposure to a hazardous chemical under normal conditions of use."

If, in the future, there is a change in the standard or in our electrical components that would require us to provide an MSDS, we will certainly comply with the standard.
